The challenge of Og, King of Bashan

‘And God said to Moshe: do not fear him (Og, the king of Bashan)...’ (Bemidbar 21,34)

At the end of our Sidra, with Bnei Yisrael on the eastern side of the River Jordan, Moshe is faced with a military challenge from Og, king of Bashan which was one of the neighbouring territories. Bnei Yisrael had, due to the help of God, enjoyed stunning success when attacked by their enemies. Why now does Moshe feel afraid when facing Og? When asking this question, it is worth noting the similar placement of the battle with Amalek, at the end of the Sidra of Beshalach (Shemot 17:8), after Bnei Yisrael had complained. The complaints are particularly significant in both contexts.

Rashi, on our verse quoting the Midrash, explains that Moshe was worried that Og, who was a powerful but aged warrior, still enjoyed some merit from his encounters with Abraham (for why this would be the case, look at Bereishit 14:13). Bnei Yisrael, it would seem, had merited such amazing help from God when attacked by the enemies because of their religious devotion and because of God’s commitment to the people. Why might Moshe be worried that Og, who now wished to attack Bnei Yisrael and presumably had far less merit, might be more worthy of protection than Bnei Yisrael?

Perhaps an answer lies in what happened in our sidra. The people complained several times, such as after the death of Miriam and the subsequent cessation of the miraculous well which had existed in her merit (see BT Ta’anit 9a and Rashi on 20:2) Mayim (water) is one of the words found in Miriam’s name. As the Talmud puts it, when somebody causes a rebellion against his teacher, it is as if he causes a rebellion against God (Sanhedrin 110a). The people complained to Moshe for bringing them out of Egypt, rather than expressing gratitude (see Bemidbar 20:1-3).

Lack of gratitude is a serious spiritual problem, perhaps to the extent that Moshe was worried that the people might have lost spiritual standing in this regard, especially when compared to Og who was spared when Abraham had to fight against hostile enemies in Bereishit (as quoted above).

Moshe too may have been worried as to his spiritual status after the striking of the rock. God therefore reassured Moshe that he need not worry. Perhaps, just as Bnei Yisrael ultimately responded well enough to change their attitude so they need not fear Og. Moshe’s remarkable response to being forbidden to enter the Land also provided extra spiritual merit. Either way, they need not fear Og and emerge unscathed from Og’s hostile endeavours.
