Kid Stuff

If you pause for a moment and ask "What am I doing here in shul? I could be in any one of a million other places, but I am here and about to hear Kriat HaTorah, which, incidentally, I probably won't pay any attention to and won't understand... So why bother?" you will have asked the same question which intrigues the Gemara [חגיגה ג.]

Moses tells the children of Israel that at the end of every Sabbatical (Seventh/Shmitta) year at Succot, when everyone will be celebrating in Jerusalem,

"You shall read this Torah before all Israel in their hearing. Gather the men, women and kids (טף) and the stranger that is within thy gates, that they may hear and they may **learn and fear** the Lord your G-d, and observe to do all the words of this Torah. And that their children (ובניהן), who do not know, may **learn to fear** the Lord your G-d" [Devarim 31, 12-13]

Imagine the total confusion. The king mounts the podium. Thousands strain to hear him read from the Torah and every child, clutching his or her cuddly lulav and biblical Barbie doll, strains to get away from a crushing crowd and an incomprehensible ceremony. Now wouldn't it be much more fun to try pulling the fruit down from the roof of the Succah? Wouldn't the men and women and stranger hear and learn and fear a whole lot better if the kids weren't around?

The Gemara explains that the men and the women are learning and hearing "but why take the kids? **To bring about a reward upon those that bring them**". Implicit in this answer is that the kids are going to get nothing out of it themselves, excepting boredom and possibly a bag of sweets if they behave themselves.

Ramban concludes that the kid in question must be one close in age to the ability to "hear and learn", but not there yet. It must be a kid who will ask "What's going on, why am I here?", so that his parents can explain and in the future he will "learn **to fear**" G-d. Only when he has matured beyond this stage will he both learn Torah **and** fear G-d.

What greater reward could a parent wish for? By bringing one's kids up in an environment imbued with Torah one sets the scene for them to become Torah observant Jews.

The Gemara [סופרים פ"ח] identifies this as the source and justification for bringing kids to shul; they will become accustomed to their parents' respect for the service and will later take it upon themselves.

The strength of this education is not that coming to shul engenders a familiarity with the service. That applies to the older kid - one who is already within the learning framework. Here, we are concentrating on the younger kid, who is able to sense that Mummy and Daddy find shul an awesome, solemn and sacred place - "learn **to** fear". Consequently, there is a heavy onus upon the adults to be true role models and inspire the younger ones. If the parents are less than paragons of devotion, then the message will not be transmitted, and the reward cannot ensue.

Don Isaac Abarbanel observes that the Ramban and others have a flawed understanding of the Chumash. It is wrong, he notes, to confuse the טף with the ובניהן, the kid with the children of the subsequent verse. These "children" belong to the generation which follows the "man and the woman **and the kid**." Therefore, if one educates one's kid correctly, then one's **grandchildren** will learn to fear. Our own conduct in shul, our respect for the Torah and our reverence for its scholars will set the tone not only for our kids, but for many generations to come.

Perhaps this is what was in the mind of the great sixteenth century Talmudist, the Maharam Shiff (d1644), who comments that the word טף (kid) has a special quality. The letters before and after the "ט" are וּחֵ while those before and after the "ף" are עֵץ. Read together one has "עץ חי" a "living tree". When we return the Sefer Torah to the ark we call it "a living tree for those who seize it."

The Torah and our children are our lifeline across the generations. Rooted in our past and branching out into our future, may we bring them together and reap the reward.

Rt Hon Lord John Alderdice

John Alderdice is a Psychiatrist by profession, but as Leader of the Alliance Party of Northern Ireland, he played a significant role in the Talks on Northern Ireland including the negotiation of the 1998 Good Friday Agreement. He was the first Speaker of the new Northern Ireland Assembly and has held many international positions including as President of Liberal International. Since 1996 he has sat as a Liberal Democrat life member of the House of Lords, and is currently Director of the Centre for the Resolution of Intractable Conflict and Chairman of the Centre for Democracy and Peace Building in Belfast. Lord Alderdice's areas of special interest are the individual and group psychology of terrorism and violent political conflict and the psychology of religious fundamentalism.
