The Priestly Blessings by Rabbi Michael Laitner

Speak to Aaron and his sons saying, thus shall you bless the Children of Israel; say to them...' (Bemidbar 6,23)

This and the subsequent four verses are the source for the wording of *Birkat Kohanim*, the Priestly blessings, which emanate from God via the conduit of the Kohanim. The exclusivity of Kohanim in this regard seems to apply only to *duchanin*, the special blessing recited in the Diaspora only on Yom Tov, according to Ashkenazi custom, but every day in many Israeli communities and many Sephardi communities in the Diaspora. In fact, non-Kohanim can and do use this blessing outside of the context of *duchanin*, such as parents blessing children on Friday nights and the Chazan every day in the repetition of the Shacharit Amida.

Why do Ashkenazi Diaspora communities *duchan* only on Yom Tov? Rabbi Moses Iserlis, the great 16th century Ashkenazi halachist, in his notes on the *Shulchan Aruch* (the Code of Jewish Law) explains that Kohanim must be in a state of *simcha* (happiness) in order to perform *Birkat Kohanim*. The only days which qualify in the Diaspora are Yom Tov, when there is a commandment to be in a state of *simcha*, by enjoying the day to a greater extent than even on Shabbat. Even so, on Yom Tov, *duchanin* only takes place in the Musaf prayer, as that is close to the end of the service when congregants will soon be able to enjoy a festive meal which is one of the main components of this *simcha*.

Why is the custom different in Israel? The late former Chief Rabbi, Lord Immanuel Jakobovits, explains that only in Israel, where the Jews are at home, is the *simcha* such that *Birkat Kohanim* can take place on a daily basis, in comparison to the fact of exile even in the most welcoming of Diasporas. As we come out of Shavuot, the festival celebrating the receiving of the Torah, we pray that we may be able to learn, understand and apply the Torah, celebrating the *simcha* of the Land of Israel, speedily in our days.

Now We are Ninety-Six

was a fitting Jubilee-themed weekend with Torah, cheesecake and scones with cream and jam.

Thanks to **Sharon Laitner, Emma Sosnow** and the **150plus volunteers** who festooned Kinloss with about 1,500 paper flowers; **Rabbi Laitner**

for the shiurim which opened and closed the chag; **Rabbi Johnny Solomon**, our visiting scholar, who presented eight times on a variety of topical and inspirational issues; **Chief Rabbi Mirvis** for his keynote on the Jewish approach to Monarchy; **Chava Wulwick** for her shiurim on King David's ancestry, to **Harry, Liora, Rafi & Shira Joseph** and everyone who contributed to the great youth tikkun and programme; to **Eleanor Mansfield and Mark Hurst**, who opened up their home for a wonderful women's tikkun, **Baroness Ros Altmann** and **Harris Bor** for the Three Crowns Panel; **Michal Bassalian, Coral Harding, Natalie Sommer, Ella Schuchman and Orli Ruback**, for the children's services; to **everyone who helped** with kiddushim, security, welcoming; to **anyone I have overlooked** and to **everyone who joined in!**

The Abarbanel (Vayikra 25) explains that while the biblical Jubilee marked a collective and national fifty-year landmark, it served to remind us that we each have around fifty productive years after about ten years of childhood. Thereafter we are in the "Kabbalat Shabbat" of our seventh decade and should devote those latter years to spiritual accomplishment.

The Talmud (Eruvin 13b) records that Beit Shammai and Beit Hillel argued for two and a half years whether it was better that humans had been created or would have been better if they had not. They resolved that it would have been better for humans not to have been created – but now that they had been each should scrutinise their deeds or better yet, make their deeds meaningful.

Given the machloket and the negative spin on our very creation, there are some opinions that birthdays do not or should matter. Consider Kohellet (7,1) "Better the day of one's death than the day of birth". We certainly mark yahrzeits.



Nonetheless, there are several sources that endorse the celebration of a birthday as a day of spiritual importance and good omen (Rav Tzadok of Lublin) or an opportunity to take stock of our blessings with resolve for the future (Ktav Sofer). The Ben Ish Chai notes that his family marked birthdays as a "Yom Tov and good tidings" **יום טוב וסימן יפה** but that for men, the celebration of the anniversary of their Brit Milah would be even more appropriate and portentous.

Rav Moshe Feinstein, the Chafetz Chayim and several gedolim who did not mark regular birthdays with any particular celebration, did choose significant landmarks, 60, 70, 80, to complete a body of study, present a new publication and recite the bracha *Shehechianu* "who has kept us alive and sustained us to this season..." over a new piece of clothing.

The Ktav Sofer records his birthday prayer of thanksgiving, that he should go on to teach so that we may elevate the Torah and its values, and we may sparkle with its crown.

Such is an ethos of devoted personal service for the greater common good.

טוב שם משמן טוב A good name is better than good oil (Kohellet 7,1) We learn that a life lived with decency is better than the High Priesthood or Monarchy (both of which are anointed with fragrant oil).

We thank Her Majesty and wish her well on her seventy years of Service as Queen. The Jubilee invites us to reflect on and thank all who commit, and contribute to the growth of Torah; who strengthen our communities and who enrich the world with its teaching.

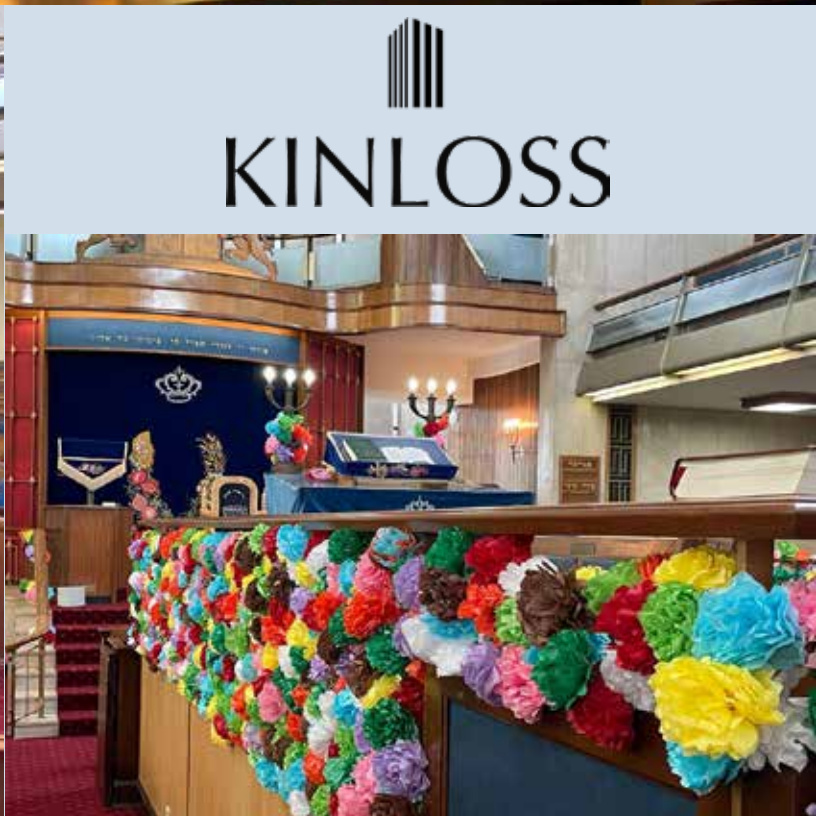
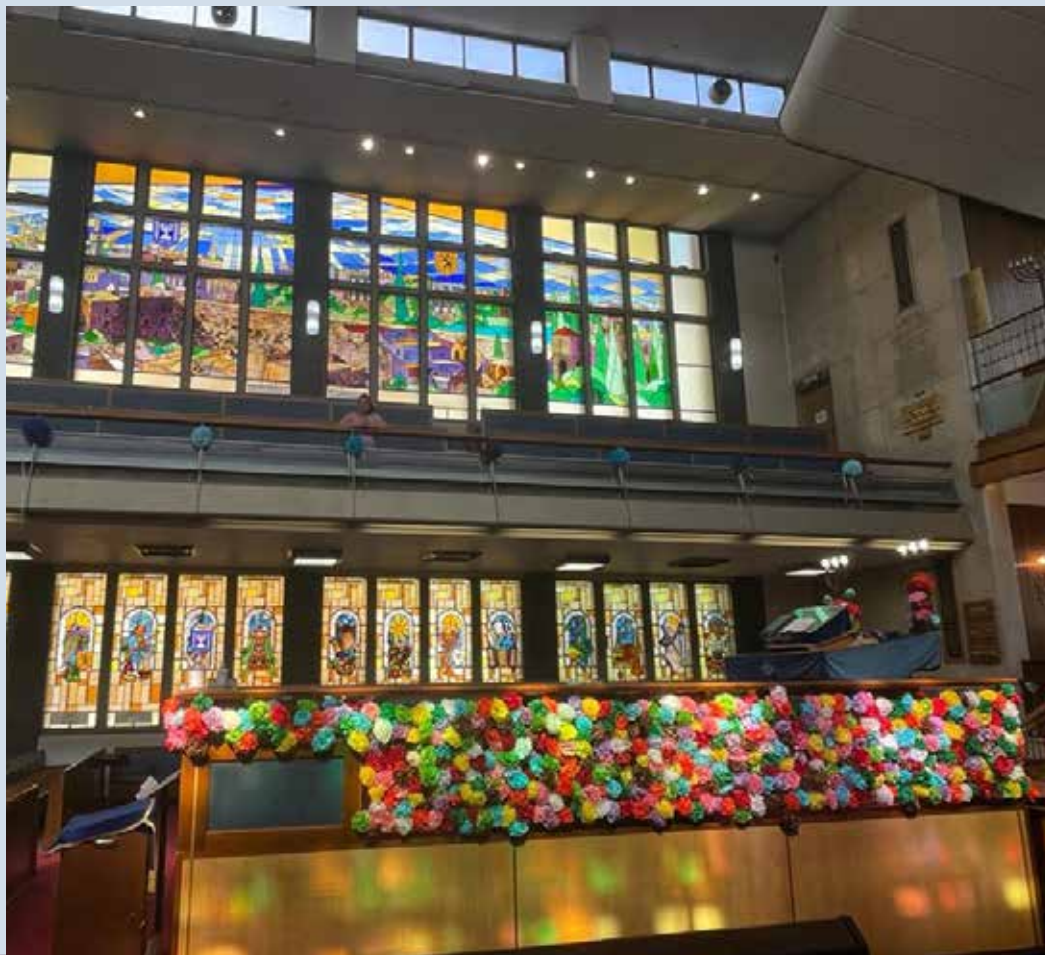
