‘But not only with you am I making this covenant... but with those standing here with us today before the Lord, our G-d, and with those who are not here with us, this day.’ Devarim, 29:13-14

Sivan Rahav-Meir, a leading Israeli broadcaster and current Shlicha in America, recounts a story between David Ben-Gurion and Yitzhak Tabenkin, a founder of the Kibbutz Movement.¹ Ben-Gurion asked advice from Tabenkin regarding the partitioning of the Land of Israel. Tabenkin agreed to offer his advice but wanted a day to take counsel from two individuals. A day later, Tabenkin urged David Ben-Gurion to refuse the offer put forward, to which Ben-Gurion followed his advice. Ben-Gurion then asked Tabenkin who the two people he consulted were, to which Tabenkin answered: ‘from two people, from my grandfather who died ten years ago, and from my grandson who is not yet born.’ In this answer Tabenkin shows his responsibility for the past and the future, for not just the people who are present but for the people who are not physically present.

This week’s Parasha tells not only of a covenant between the present and G-d, but of all generations, past and future. The beginning of Parashat Nitzavim says how all of the children of Israel, including ‘your heads of tribes, your elders, your officers, every man of Israel, your young ones, your wives, the stranger in your gate, from the wood-heaver to your wood-drawer’ are part of the covenant. No one can shy away from the covenant to make us into a real and proper nation.

The Gemara in Taanit, 23a, tells a story of Choni HaMe’aggel who was troubled by the meaning of the verse: ‘שִׁיר הַמַּעֲלֹת בְּשׁוּב הָאֶת-שִׁיבַת צִיּוֹן הָיִינוּ כְּחֹלְמִים:’ ‘A song of elevation: When the Lord brought back those who returned to Zion, we were like those who dream.’ Rashi comments that this verse of the Psalm compares the Babylonian exile to a dream lasting seventy years. Choni then saw a certain man planting a tree that took seventy years to bear fruit, asking him what the point of planting the tree is if you won’t see the fruit it bears? To help him realise the answer, Hashem sent Choni to sleep for seventy years, waking him up afterwards to see the grandchildren of the tree planter benefit from the tree.

This story not only highlights the promise and covenant of G-d and the Jewish people of the land of Israel but also highlights the need and necessity for us to prepare for our future generations. We may not be able to see the instant success of our work, but one day in the future our hard work will pay off. We must continue to invest in future Jewish generations, to make them aware that they are part of the story and they are part of an everlasting covenant between the people of Israel and G-d.

Realising the strength and importance of our youth and our future generations is a key part of realising what it really means to be a people and a nation. Only when we consider every generations do we understand what it means to be a nation.

Sivan Rahav-Meir is a prize-winning journalist and leading social media broadcaster in Israel, rated in the Jerusalem Post's top 50 influential Jews worldwide. John Mann has been MP for Bassetlaw since 2001. He resigned the Labour whip in September in order to take up the position of Government Anti-Semitism Tsar. Over the years, he has been vocal on financial propriety, drugs, child abuse and anti-Semitism. He famously confronted Ken Livingstone in a stairwell in April 2016, calling him, inter alia a "Nazi apologist." It's a moment to savour and relive on YouTube. We welcome him and look forward to his Shabbat Forum.

We also welcome **Noga Porat** and **Keren Weiss** to Kinloss, Bnot Sherut (part of the Israel's Sherut Leumi outreach programme). They will be working with our youth and are at Sacks Morasha during the week.

Thanks to everyone who has supported our Ellul programme, the shiurim with Penina Savery, R' Laitner and the wonderful Selichot Programme. Thanks also to everyone who has put in extra time and effort over the last busy period in Kinloss Cares and welfare. It was

lovely to see the celebration of community in the Kinloss Magazine. There is so much goodness and energy to fire us into the New Year.

In the shul-intensive weeks ahead, please do help us to make Kinloss welcoming and friendly as well as safe and tidy. Please encourage kids to be in places where they are properly supervised; support our security volunteers, youth service leaders and our wonderful Kinloss caretaking staff.

In our Parasha, Nitzavim, we are told that "For this commandment which I command you this day, is not hidden from you, nor is it far off. It is not in heaven, that you should say, who shall go up for us to heaven, and bring it to us, that we may hear it, and do it? Nor is it beyond the sea, that you should say, who shall go over the sea for us, and bring it to us, that we may hear it, and do it?" (Devarim 30:11-15). While there is agreement that Hashem has made it easier and more accessible, there is a celebrated discussion on the meaning of "this commandment". Is it the whole Torah (Rashi) or the opportunity for Teshuva (Ramban)?

The Talmud (Eruvin 55a) considers the possibility that even if it were over the sea or in the heavens, we would still need to strive for the seemingly unattainable. Hashem gives us opportunities and enables, but is exacting in His expectations of effort.

I'll be exploring that thought further in my **Shabbat Shuva Shiur** next week at 6.10pm.

May our collective endeavours in the weeks ahead see Hashem sign and seal us, our families and all Israel, for life for health and peace in the year ahead.

SHABBAT FORUM SPEAKER @ KINLOSS ON 28TH SEPTEMBER - JOHN MANN MP



John Mann MP was elected as Member of Parliament for Bassetlaw in June 2001. Since his time in student politics he has been vocal in his condemnation of all forms of racism and intolerance and has worked tirelessly to combat it. In the summer of 2005 he was appointed as the Chair of the All-Party Parliamentary Group against Antisemitism, supported by the Antisemitism Policy Trust. John has commissioned two major All-Party Inquiries into Antisemitism and a further inquiry into Electoral Conduct. In 2008, John established the Inter-Parliamentary Coalition for Combating Antisemitism (ICCA) which he now Chairs. In May 2009, John received the American Jewish Committee's (AJC's) Jan Karski Award in recognition of his commitment and work in fighting antisemitism. In 2010, he Chaired the Football Association's Task Force on antisemitism and Islamophobia in football.

In July 2019, John Mann was appointed as the Government's Independent Adviser on Antisemitism in one of Theresa May's final acts as Prime Minister.

On his appointment John Mann said: "If we stay silent on the issue of antisemitism, we unwittingly allow cowardice and bigotry to speak its own repulsive language. I will continue to call out those throwing stones of hatred at Jewish people and will endeavour to give a clarion call to Government on prejudice and discrimination on this issue."
