Some Thoughts on the Sidra

Looking back – Leora Salter

“The LORD said to Moses: “Carve two tablets of stone like the first ones, and I will inscribe upon the tablets the words that were on the first tablets, which you shattered.” (Exodus 34:1)

On Shabbat Chol Hamoed we read from Parashat Ki Tissa, most commonly known for the sin of the Golden Calf. However, we pick up the storyline from the aftermath, when Moshe begs Hashem to accompany the Jewish people into the Land of Israel, instead of sending an angel. Hashem agrees to this request but instructs Moshe to ‘carve two tablets of stone like the first ones.’

Even though the Jewish people have just committed the sin of the Golden Calf, G-d commands Moshe to inscribe another set of the Ten Commandments, just the same as the first ones. The new set of tablets signified a new start for the Jewish people, a new era of reconciliation.

However, the new era did not erase the past. Just because the Jewish people have now been forgiven, it did not mean that they can just forget about the past and move on to a new beginning. The Children of Israel would continue their journey through the wilderness on their quest to get to the Land of Israel with both the new set of tablets and the old set, which our Sages commented that they lay beside in the Ark. This is here to teach us a very important lesson. This is not just a physical location or coincidence, rather it is a spiritual teaching and lesson.

Wherever the Jewish people wander, they will carry their sins and forgiveness, the shattered and the whole, with them.

Cracks were formed in the idyllic existence, but from a certain perspective the new reality is even more whole. The famous lesson of ‘learn from your mistakes’ is forefront of this message. When you have done something wrong or have overcome a crisis, you emerge stronger and more mature than before, realising what you have to develop and strengthen. Life’s journey will continue, but memory of failures will help us and give us strength to continue.

It is no coincidence that we read this leining on Shabbat Chol HaMoed of Succot. As we have just finished with Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur, asking Hashem for forgiveness, Succot is the perfect opportunity to recognise our mistakes and go again for another year. As we approach Hoshana Rabbah, when our judgement for the year is sealed, we should take the lessons from the Torah reading and look back on the past, ask for true and proper forgiveness, and build and learn from our previous lows in order to improve and develop ourselves for the coming year.

Rabbi Lawrence In Conversation with...

• **Wednesday 30th October - 8pm**

Rt Hon Lord John Alderdice

John Alderdice is a Psychiatrist by profession, but as Leader of the Alliance Party of Northern Ireland, he played a significant role in the Talks on Northern Ireland including the negotiation of the 1998 Good Friday Agreement. He was the first Speaker of the new Northern Ireland Assembly and has held many international positions including as President of Liberal International. Since 1996 he has sat as a Liberal Democrat life member of the House of Lords, and is currently Director of the Centre for the Resolution of Intractable Conflict and Chairman of the Centre for Democracy and Peace Building in Belfast. Lord Alderdice's areas of special interest are the individual and group psychology of terrorism and violent political conflict and the psychology of religious fundamentalism.

Marie van der Zyl

Marie van der Zyl was elected President of the Board of Deputies of British Jews in May 2018. In the past three years she has played a crucial part in the fight against antisemitism in the Labour Party. Her quote, labelling the Chakrabarti report as a "whitewash", was carried widely across national media. Marie was at the forefront of the campaign against the so-called "cab-rank" policy, by which the Inner North London Coroner delayed the release of bodies to Jewish families. Her negotiations resulted in its adoption of the internationally recognised IHRA definition of antisemitism.

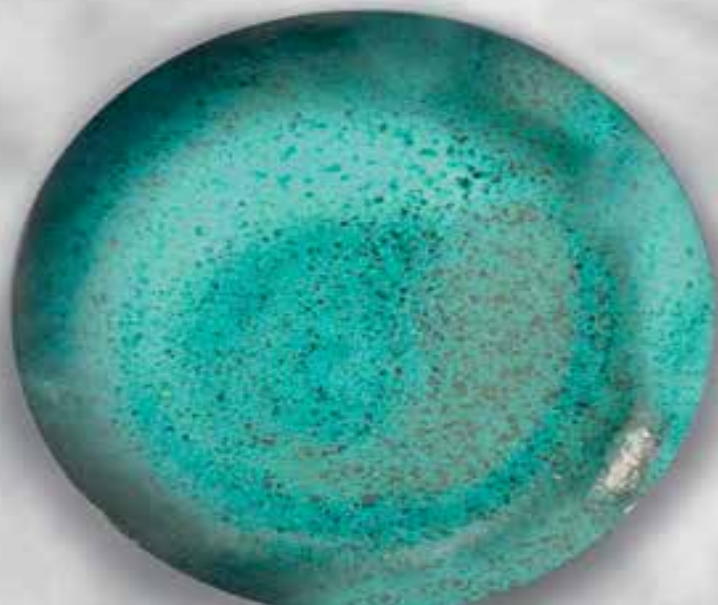
