Truth Dressed in Metaphor

On Shavuot we read the book of Ruth, a story dressed in rich metaphor.

Our Book is set in the immediate aftermath of a devastating famine – the Global Financial Crisis of its era. A man called Elimelech, whose name means “my God is King” has left his home in Bet-Lechem, which means “the house of bread”.

In exile, his sons die. Their names as recorded in the Book of Chronicles are Yoash and Seraf. But here, in the book of Ruth they are called Machlon and Chilyon – names implying Sickness and Destruction – not the kind of names we’d choose for our children.

As you know, Ruth follows Naomi back to Israel...

“Wherever you go, I will go;” Like Abraham and Sarah, I will follow God’s path. “And where you lodge, I will lodge;” I shall keep a Jewish Home. “Your people shall be my people,” I shall be a part of the Jewish Community. “And your God my God;” I shall observe the Jewish faith. “Where you die, will I die, and there will I be buried;” My commitment is lifelong, and my soul is Hashem’s in the afterlife.

At the very end of the book, Ruth and Boaz have a son, whom they call Oved.

The name implies being a dutiful servant and a follower. He was called Oved because Boaz was a dutiful servant of God – looking to do the right thing by Jewish law, for his family and also for his employees.

And he was called Oved because Ruth embraced the way of God, followed Naomi and honoured her extended family ties.

Oved is the grandfather of King David, born in Bet-Lechem.

Though set far back in our nation’s history, the story has relevance today. Elimelech was no desperate economic refugee. Rather, he was a man of substance. In fact, Midrashim are critical of his opportunistic, lack of faith, claiming he abandoned Israel to look after his immediate family, rather than contributing their collective energy and resources to the cause of welfare at home. It’s one of the explanations of the pejorative nicknames of his children.

It is also why Naomi is initially given the cold shoulder on her return and says her name is Mara – or bitter.

Even before we get to the inner tale of Ruth, important lessons are being taught.

The truth dressed in metaphor:

When we abandon Bet-Lechem “the House of Bread”, anticipating prosperity elsewhere, we alienate our children from their heritage and destine them to spiritual sickness and destruction.

Ruth and Naomi show that we can pick up and return.

Boaz, who stayed firm, teaches that we should welcome people back and welcome them in.

This is the message of Shavuot; to embrace Hashem and embrace His way. To follow His word, requires that we honour our families and all humanity.

The story teaches that though we might start off in a house of bread our children may go on to reign in Jerusalem.

And the truth without metaphorical dressing? If we look to the Torah and follow its ways, however humble our original home, we may dwell in the Palace of Hashem.

Shavuot celebrates our acceptance of the Torah, the embrace of Jewish values, women of character and *chesed*.

I look forward to you joining us as we celebrate these in Kinloss. We have an amazing Tikkun Leil and many learning opportunities through the night and days of Chag. We shall be honouring our Neshei Chayil, who draw their strength and inspire us through community and *chesed*.

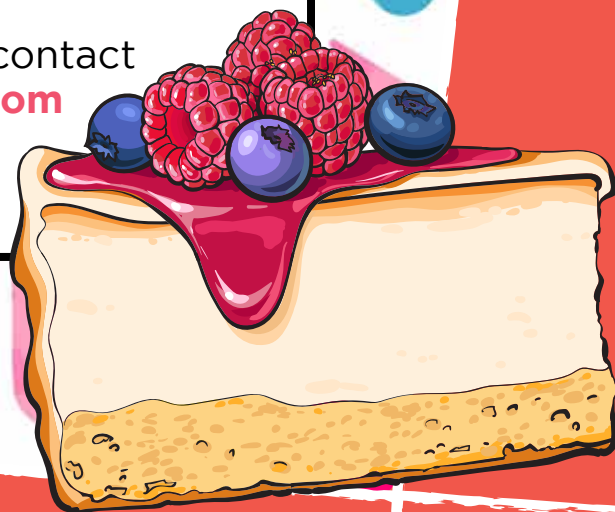
