The special nature of the Land of Israel

‘Because the Land to which you are coming to, to possess, is not like the land of Egypt, which you left, where you would sow seeds, and water it by foot like a vegetable garden. The Land to which you will cross over (the river Jordan) to possess is a Land of hills and valleys, from the rain of the heavens, you will drink water. A Land to which the Lord your God pays special attention. Always, the Lord your God’s eyes are on it, from the beginning of the year, to the year’s end’. (Devarim 11:10-12)

What is the main difference between the Land of Israel and Egypt emerging from these verses? The two countries are not distinguished simply by topographical factors. Rather, the verses also emphasise that God’s ‘attention’ seems to be focused more closely on Israel than on Egypt.

These verses also teach that the spiritual connection between God and us is far more pronounced in Israel than it is in Egypt.

That connection is what makes the Land of Israel spiritually superior, as Rashi points out when explaining our verses. In Egypt, it was easy to forget the rule of God, since water was bountiful. Contrastingly, Israel is a land of “hills and valleys” where provision of water is more closely linked to Divine Providence and our behaviour, than the ‘guaranteed’ water available in Egypt.

This has practical ramifications as to the effects of our behaviour. We can infer from the explanations of Ramban, that if Jews labour well in Israel, both spiritually and physically, they will not only reap their reward of water but also relish it, having become better people in the process, instead of being complacent and lacking gratitude for water.

This message is emphasised by the next section in the Torah, familiar to us as the second paragraph of the Shema. A major theme of that paragraph is that of reward and punishment, expressed there through the medium of rain, which generally falls only in the winter even though water is needed all year.

Rain in Israel is not simply a physical phenomenon. It seems a paradigm for Divine Providence as the ‘eyes’ of God are on the Land. Reward for following the Torah is expressed through rain and vice versa. This also alludes to a strong connection between developing the Land of Israel physically and developing the character of the nation as followers of the Torah.

In analysing our verses, the late Chief Rabbi Lord Jakobovits, in his work, Mishnat HaSar, emphasises the special spiritual nature of the Land of Israel and how it can be considered at the spiritual centre of the world. It is in Israel that Divine Providence seems most pronounced, and spreads out to the rest of the world, just like the heart pumps blood around the body. This is the main difference between Israel and Egypt, as taught by these verses.
