Laughter Lines

As Parshat Vayera opens, Avraham welcomes angels into his tent and receives the prophecy that within a year, he and Sarah shall have a son.

Even good news can come as a surprise.

Overhearing the conversation, we are told, (Bereishit 18:12) **וַתצַחֵק** שָׂרָה בְּקִרְבָּהּ And Sarah laughed to herself. She considered that both she and Avraham were too old.

Hashem chastises Avraham for his wife's incredulity. However, Sarah had not been alone in receiving this news with laughter.

Sarah's conception of Yitzchak had already been foretold. At the end of last week's Parasha, as he changes their names from Avram and Sarai, Hashem, himself, had told Avraham that they would have a child. Avraham's reaction was also to laugh (Bereishit 17:17) **וַיִּצְחַק**. ויפל אברהם על פניו ויצחק. However, he is not chastised. Rather, Hashem instructs him that the child shall be called Yitzchak, meaning laughter.

In explaining the difference between the unchallenged laughter of Avraham and Sarah's laughter, which was criticized, Rashi cites the translation of Onkelos which distinguishes between Avraham's **וַיִּצְחַק** as laughter of joy, whereas Sarah's was the laughter of ridicule.

לִשְׁוֹן שְׂמֵחָהּ, וְחָדִי, וְשָׁל שָׂרָה לִשְׁוֹן מְחוּרָה

That the Torah uses the same language in both instances highlights the fine line between humour and mockery.

Defending Sarah, Rashi notes that overhearing Avraham's guests, she had no idea that they were angels on a divine mission. For all she knew, they were



passers-by, and their remarks were enthusiastic small-talk or flattery for the host and his family.

We learn much about Avraham's disposition in Parashat Vayera; his hospitality, his sense of justice and compassion (pleading for Sodom and Gemorra) as well as his alacrity in the service of Hashem, when the times and the terms are hard (the Akeida).

Each opportunity and eventuality in life calls on us to respond in a godly manner; sometimes to challenge, sometimes to accept and comply.

The Torah teaches that whatever we face, it is a constant blessing to be servants of Hashem and charged, like Avraham, to faithfully represent godly values in the face of a troubled world.

Celebrating Wisdom and Scholarship

This Shabbat we are delighted to welcome Rabbi Professor Avraham Steinberg to Kinloss.



Rav Steinberg is the Director of Medical Ethics at the Shaarei Tzedek Medical Centre in Jerusalem. He studied medicine, and later specialised in paediatric neurology with hospital experience in Israel and New York. He compiled the seven volume Encyclopaedia of Jewish Medical Ethics, for which he won the prestigious Israel Prize in 1999.

He attained the rank of Major in the Israeli Airforce

He is currently chief of the Editorial Board of the Talmudic Encyclopedia (Encyclopedia Talmudit). This is a remarkable project started in 1947 by Rabbi Meir Bar Ilan (1880-1949), who was the son of the distinguished head of the Yeshiva of Volozhyn, Rabbi Naftali Tzvi Berlin, the Netziv. Berlin became Bar Ilan. Bar Ilan University is named after him.

The Talmudic Encyclopedia is an unparalleled work of Halachic literature which compiles, summarizes and explains the vast range of Torah knowledge on every topic in Jewish law, from Biblical times to the present. It is highly regarded for its clear, accurate and thorough entries. Across the Torah spectrum, the Encyclopedia is celebrated as authoritative. For scholars, it joins the great codices of Jewish Law on the shelves as a comprehensive and contemporary reference.

There are 48 completed volumes, containing approximately 1600 entries through the letter Mem. Now, over halfway, the aim is to reach the end of the Alphabet by 2024. In the interim, a simplified Micropedia is also being published.

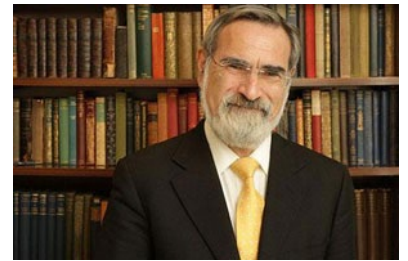
In Pirkei Avot 1, 4 we learn

Rav Steinberg was enthusiastic to tie his visit in with the second Yahrzeit of the late Chief Rabbi Lord Jonathan Sacks.



A volume of the Encyclopedia Talmudit is being dedicated in Rabbi Sacks' honour.

For many of us, Rabbi Sacks was the contemporary voice of our scholarship, faith and the enduring role of the Jewish people.

Rabbi Sacks offered guidance in a world of moral equivocation, hope in times of turmoil, and the imagination that individually and collectively, we could aspire to be better and do better. Rabbi Sacks' books adorn our shelves. We relished the opportunities to hear him. His radio broadcasts and public addresses made us think and made us proud. An inspiration; he changed many of our lives.

Rabbi Sacks' yahrzeit falls on Monday night 13th and Tuesday 14th November. We join in wishing אַרְיָכוֹת יָמִים to Lady Elaine, to Josh, Dina, Gila, to Brian, Alan and Eliot and all their families.

On Wednesday morning this week we welcomed back an 8am Shacharit Minyan, which we shall continue weekly with breakfast and a short shiur. On alternate weeks I will be looking at the Book of Mishlei (Proverbs). The book opens with the line מְשָׁלִי שְׁלֹמֹה בֶן-דָּוִד מֶלֶךְ יִשְׂרָאֵל. "The proverbs of Solomon son of David, king of Israel". The Netziv (see above, 1816-1893) asks why three designations of Solomon are used. He explains that it calls him "Solomon", who was wise and upon whom the spirit of God rested. It calls him "son of David" to highlight his respect for ancestral tradition. It calls him "King of Israel" to highlight his discernment and experience, perfected by being in the company of many sages.

How privileged we are to have the opportunities to let our house be a house of meeting for the great scholars, to keep their company, to continue to know them, draw inspiration and drink in their words with thirst.

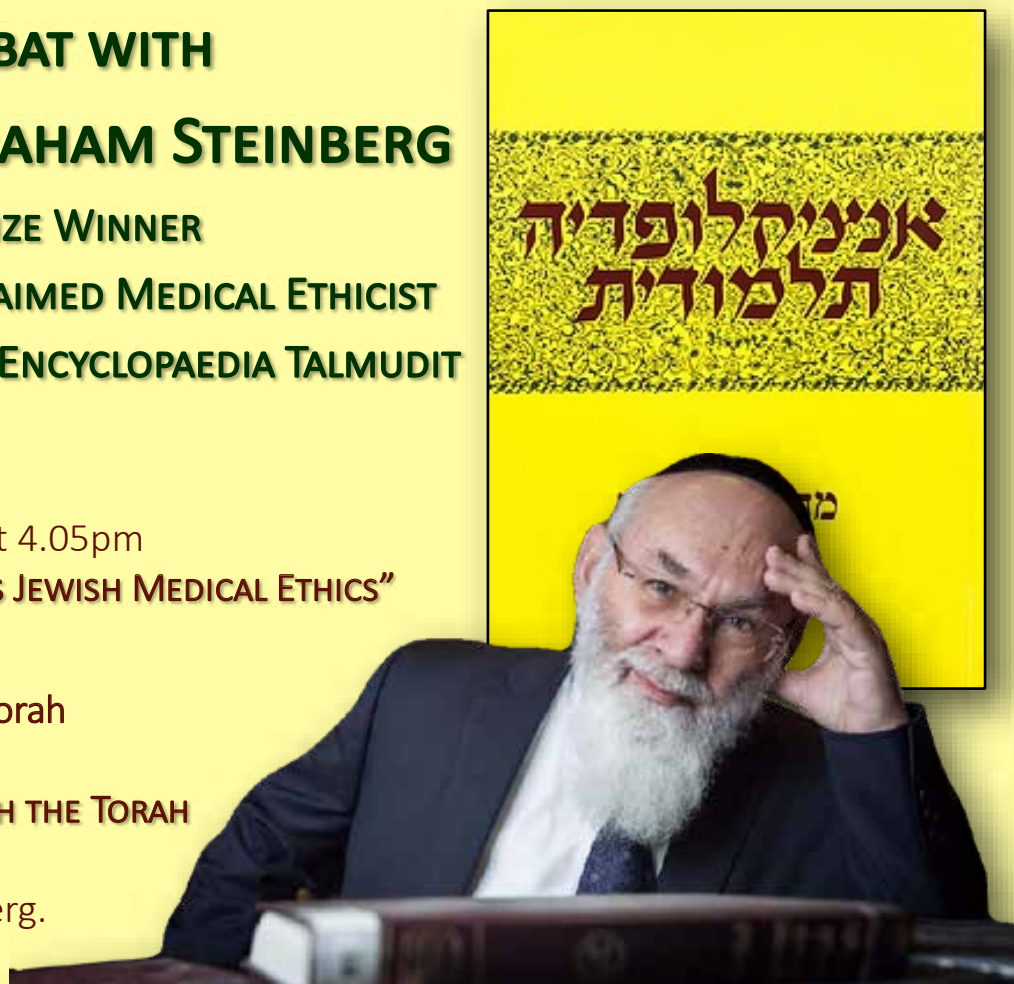

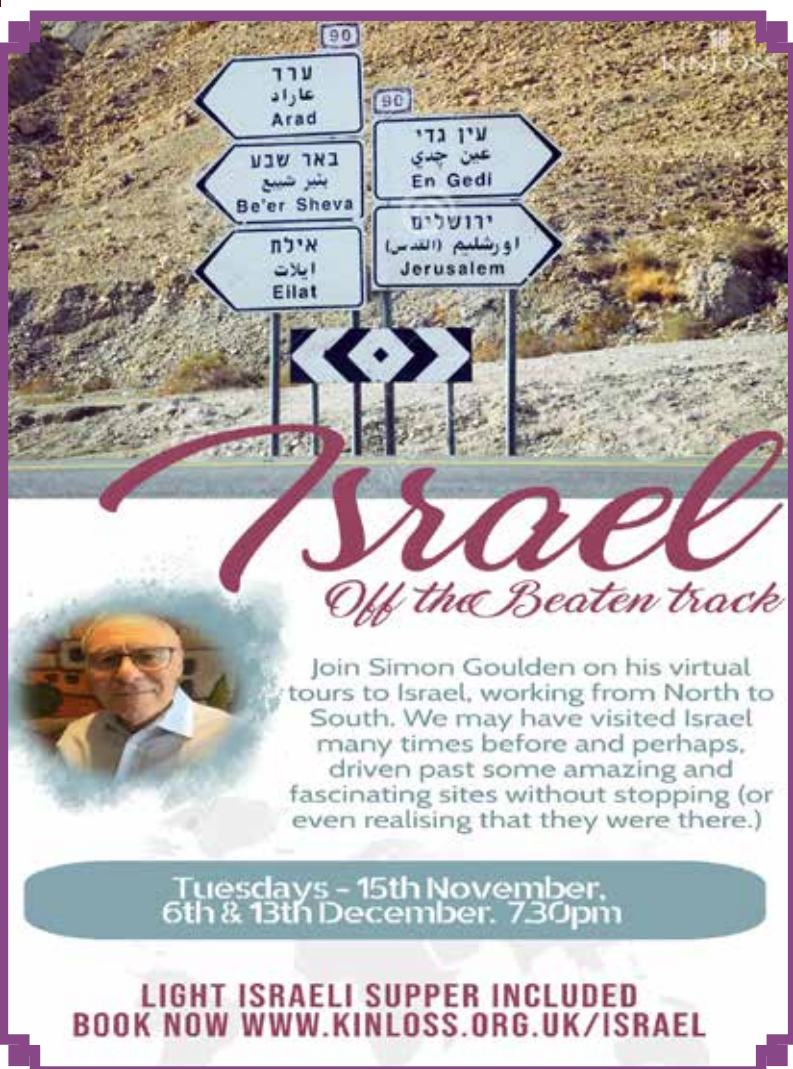
