

GUIDED TOUR OF THE JEWISH EAST END & VISIT TO THE V&A MUSEUM OF CHILDHOOD

Monday 15th October 2018

A walk through time through the history of London's Jewish community in the East End and a tour of the nation's childhood collection of toys and childhood artefacts.

The tour encompasses a tale that embraces the poverty of the pogrom refugees and the glittering success of the Rothschilds; the eloquence of Prime Minister Disraeli and the spiel of the Petticoat Lane stallholder. 
