The Gemara (Pesachim, 56a) recounts the final moments of our forefather Yaakov's life. Yaakov's children were gathered around his bedside and Yaakov wanted to reveal to them the time of Mashiach's, arrival. However, he was unable to as just at that moment the Devine Presence departed from him. Yaakov worried that perhaps this had happened as there was a spiritual blemish in one of his children. Seeing their father gripped with fear that one of his children might have gone 'off the derech' they said to him the verse we say twice every day, which is found in this week's sedra - שמע ישראל - Hear, O (our father) Israel: the L-rd our G-d, the L-rd is One. (Their father Yaakov was also called Israel - Yisrael, which is why we are called B'nei Yisrael). They continued to reassure their father that they were spiritually and morally upstanding, by saying, "Just as in your heart there is only One, so too in our heart there is only One." Hearing this Yaakov called out to thank G'd and said, ברוך שם כבוד מלכותו לעולם ועד - Blessed be the name of the glory of His kingdom forever and ever (the phrase we insert after saying Shema).

The children said "Just as in *your heart* there is only One, so too in our heart there is also only One' - why did they mention Yaakov's heart? It was obvious that Yaakov was dedicated to one G'd. All they needed to say was "Shema Yisrael".

A further question can be asked on the first paragraph of Shema. We are told to love G'd, to carry these words in our hearts, then we are instructed to teach Torah to our children and students and the paragraph ends with saying we should speak words of Torah when we lie down, when we get up and when we are going about our day. (The way we come to love G'd is through our commitment to the 613 Mitzvot, many of which are mentioned in Sefer Devraim. The root of the word love - אהבה is הו which means to give. As Rabbi Sacks z"l explains rituals are the framework that keep love alive). So, the paragraph starts by talking about the individual, their emotions and behaviour, then interrupts with instructions for educating our children, and then comes back to speak to the individual. The question is, why does it not first give us all the instructions on how to behave and then instruct us on how to teach our children. Why is the section about

teaching our children in the middle of the instructions to us?

Before we answer these questions, just one more question! Rabbi Moshe Alshich (1507-1600) asks why does the Torah use the word ושנתם , when telling us to teach our children, rather than the much more common word for teaching - ולמדתם?

The root of the word ושנתם is שנה which means 'sharp' (as in Tehillim 120:4, which talks about 'sharp arrows'). If you want an arrow to reach its target one must first pull it back towards one's heart. The Alshich mentions two types of education. The type that affects the heart and soul of the person being taught, and the type where the words feel irrelevant to the person listening and are rejected. If our words come from the depths of our heart they are more likely to arrive in the heart of the child or student we are teaching.

This allows us to understand the sequence of the verses in the first paragraph of Shema. We cannot educate our children, unless the words are first in our hearts, we are passionate about them and our identity as the Jewish people. We can't convey to our children how to live up to their Jewish destiny unless the words resonate within ourselves. If we are passionate and committed to Torah and our identity as Jewish people, then our words will be like arrows that can reach their target, the hearts of our children.

Yaakov was worried one of his children was morally blemished, so his children explained, just as in your heart there is only One, so too in our heart there is also One. The reason they were upstanding individuals was because their hearts reflected the heart of their father. Children mirror their parents' hearts, not their words. If we look at our own parents, we know what influenced us most were not the lectures or rewards, but what we saw our parents were committed to, loved and were passionate about in a genuine way. The core of education is "Words that come from the heart, enter the heart." This is how after thousands of years of existence, we have survived and thrived, as we have never lost our love for our children, and our obligation to pass on our values across the generations.

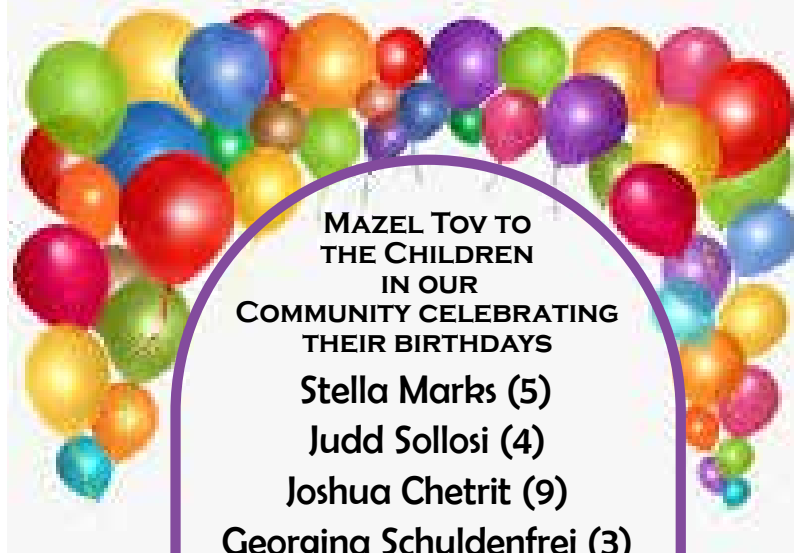
