My very first experience of the wonderful community of Kinloss is when Rebecca and I were married by Chief Rabbi Mirvis back in 1996. We were privileged that our wedding was one of the first that he officiated at in Kinloss. After living in Australia and then Israel for a few years, we came to London, and naturally the community we chose to join was Kinloss. We have been grateful for all the special friendships that have been developed and cultivated within the community.

Over the years, we have become involved in the Shul in different ways; I was a security team leader for 15 years, Gabbai of the Minyan for the past 5 years until November 2021, and currently working on relaunching the Kinloss Business Club. We are very proud that our children have all been actively involved in the Youth Service and Bnei Akiva through Kinloss.

I am both honoured and humbled to have Chatan Bereishit bestowed upon me.
